Signature of a Convention between the Government of Ireland and the Government of the Kingdom of Thailand for the Avoidance of Double Taxation and the Prevention of Fiscal Evasion with respect to Taxes on Income and Capital Gains

WHEREAS a Convention between the Government of Ireland and the Government of the Kingdom of Thailand for the Avoidance of Double Taxation and the Prevention of Fiscal Evasion with respect to Taxes on Income and Capital Gains, has been elaborated;

AND WHEREAS the Government of Ireland have seen the said Convention and deemed it appropriate that the said Convention should be signed, subject to notification of the completion of the procedures required by law for the bringing into force of the Convention, on their behalf;
